ALTA, LIVING WATER COMMUNITY, GIFT FOR LIFE GET SUPPORT FROM COMTRUST FOUNDATION

Port of Spain. 2 December 2022. The season of giving and sharing was evident at CIBC FirstCaribbean when the bank recently made some charitable donations.

Through its ComTrust Foundation, Living Waters Community, Adult Literacy Tutors Association (ALTA) and the Gift for Life Foundation received necessary funding that will assist with their Christmas preparation.

At the centre of those areas of support is the uplifting and empowering of people in communities where the bank has a presence.

The Living Water Community is a Catholic Ecclesial Community which began in Port of Spain in 1975. It was founded by Rhonda Maingot and Rose Jackman. The community has been a vibrant ministry to the poor in Trinidad as there continues to be a need for basic care, nourishment and self-development programmes managed in an efficient, cost-effective manner.

ALTA has been in existence since 1992. It provides the only comprehensive, structured, adult literacy programme in Trinidad and Tobago.

Representing the organisations were Shaks Ragoonanan from The Gift For Life Foundation; Michelle Acqui from the Living Water Community and Judith Affoo from ALTA.
