Bridgetown, Barbados, 03 July 2023. Activities leading up to the biggest walk for a cause in the Caribbean have already started, with the Annual Walk for the Cure set to take place on Sunday October 1st 2023.

He has also conducted classes in London, New York, Washington DC, Montreal and Toronto having been invited to these international cities.
