## CIBC FirstCaribbean Walk For The Cure Raises \$6-M For The Jamaica Cancer

**Kingston, Jan. 29, 2024 -** CIBC FirstCaribbean is singing the praises of sponsors and participants of the 2023 Walk For The Cure (WFTC) 5K Run/Walk, for helping the bank raise \$6-m for the benefit of the Jamaica Cancer Society.

Managing Director, Nigel Holness, in welcoming guests to a cheque presentation ceremony at the bank's Knutsford Boulevard branch on January 18, 2024, thanked them all for their "partnership in the crusade against cancer".

Noting that when the bank began the WFTC in 2012, in countries across the region in which it operates, it was a deliberate commitment to support the region's cancer organizations, Mr. Holness said that the annual event is now the Caribbean's largest cancer fund raising and education initiative having already raised in excess of \$465-m, not counting what was raised regionally, in 2023. The funds raised, he said, has been used to help fund patient care, outreach, research and education by cancer organizations.

Lamenting the prevalence and growth of cancer worldwide, Mr. Holness shared that several cancer survivors participated in last year's WFTC, including a young woman who revealed that she had recently received a diagnosis of breast cancer and was able to speak with an oncologist who was a guest speaker at the event.

"We either know someone who has cancer - a friend, a relative, a neighbour- maybe ourselves. Walk For the Cure is both therapeutic and beneficial whether we are running or walking for ourselves or in memory of someone else."

Mr. Holness thanked his CIBC Team who fundraised before the event, helped coordinate and manage it and participated and the sponsors who committed money, in kind products and services and also participated on race day.
